

During Urban Explorations conversations on collective memory, collective storytelling and representation emerged and gave shape to a podcast. The mono episode is based on the exchange between the host, Vienna-based Social Designer, Ana Mumladze and Jeanette Pacher, the Vienna-based curator and lecturer at die Angewandte.

The piece focuses on art in architecture and public spaces in Vienna. Emergence, context, form and impact of selected artworks is discussed with a specific emphasis on site-specific art.
